





# Training module

## Autism patient care

## **Module Description**

This interactive training module aims to develop healthcare providers' competence and confidence in caring for autistic patients through a blend of lectures, case studies, and skills workshops. Participants will gain foundational knowledge of autism spectrum disorder (ASD), explore best practices in communication, recognize comorbid conditions, and practice patient-centered care approaches in clinical settings.

#### **Academic Contents**

## • Day 1: Foundations of Autism Patient Care

- o Introduction to Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD): Core concepts, diagnostic criteria, and common myths.
- o Core presentations of ASD and associated impairments.
- Medical and psychiatric comorbidities.
- o Effective communication strategies with autistic patients and families.
- o Case studies and reflection exercises.

## • Day 2: Clinical Practice and Team Care

- o Planning wellness visits and preventive care for autistic individuals.
- Accommodations and trauma-informed care.
- o Managing challenging behaviors and crisis prevention.
- Transitions of care: Social and healthcare transitions.
- o Building and working within a multidisciplinary care team.
- o Role-play scenarios and toolkit activities.

#### **Learning Outcomes**

- Define and outline diagnostic criteria for ASD and related comorbidities.
- Apply evidence-based communication methods to support autistic patients.
- Anticipate triggers for anxiety and challenging behaviors and manage them effectively.
- Demonstrate the ability to plan and deliver autism-responsive clinical and preventive care.
- Collaborate effectively with interprofessional care teams to improve patient outcomes.
- Enhance confidence and self-efficacy in autism patient care, with lasting impact.
